It always falls on a Thursday and whilst it used to be regarded as an important day in the Christian calendar, is no longer observed as a Public holiday in the UK.

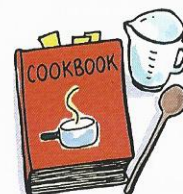
